

CLAVE AMERICANA

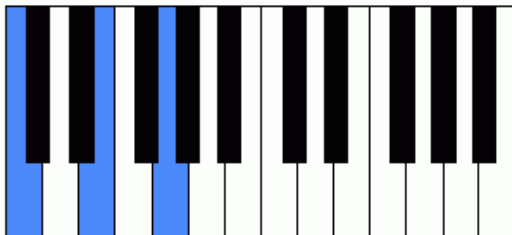
Generalmente la escritura para los instrumentos de “TECLADO” se indican con letras que se asocian a notas musicales. Este tipo de notación se denomina “Clave americana” y consiste en ocupar las 7 primeras letras del alfabeto, es decir: A, B, C, D, E, F, G. Este sistema tiene carácter universal y sirve para ejecutar los diferentes acordes del instrumento.

Entonces nos quedaría de la siguiente manera:

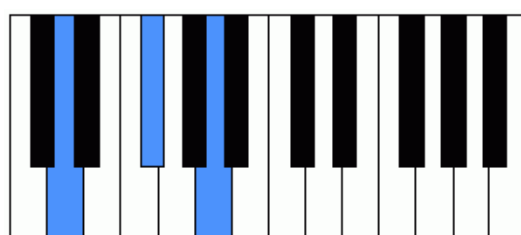

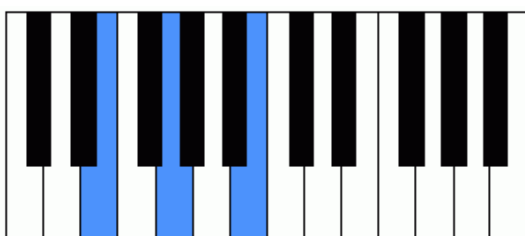
