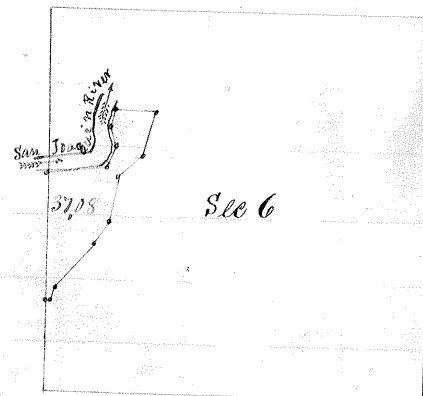

Run on Section line North 27.00 chs, to the Right bank of the San Joaquin River Meander down Stream Run N 82° E 13.24 chs, N 79° E 4.00 chs, North 4.25 chs, N 42° E 3.00 chs, to  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section line in the North  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 6 Run on  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section line East 8.50 chs, to the U. S. Meander line Run on the U. S. Meander line S 15° W 0.07 chs, S 07° W 0.30 chs, S 62° W 10.80 chs, S 42° W 5.00 chs, S 70° E 12.50 chs, S 26° E 13.18 chs, to  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section line in the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 6 Run on  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section line West, 7 chs to the place of beginning.
